

Ernie Els #GameON Autism[™] Golf Clinic

Concept:

Golf Challenge locations will host the Ernie Els #GameON Autism™ Golf Clinic for up to 18 beginner to intermediate players from 6-23 years of age. The clinic will take approximately 1.5 hours total including 30 minutes of golf, 15 minutes of bodily/kinesthetic activity and include a healthy refreshment break of 15 minutes.

Golf Facility Information:

The University of Texas Golf Club is a 7,412 yard, par71 championship-caliber golf course created by Bechtol Russell Golf Design. Built in the Texas Hill Country, the course overlooks Lake Austin and borders the Balcones Natural Wildlife Preserve, offering challenging shots and views that rival the best in Austin.

Clinic Information:

- Date 8/31/2015 clinic begins at 11:00am.
- The clinic is free and will host up to 18 youth on the autism spectrum the day will include Golf clinic, gift bag, snacks and beverages.
- Dress code: Slacks and collared shirts are the standard required dress on golf club grounds. Jeans or denim of any type and cargo pants are not permitted. Turtlenecks and mock turtleneck shirts tailored for golf are acceptable shirts. Golf shirts must be tuckedin
